

ORDINANCE NO. 08-01 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS FOR OBERLIN RESERVE SUBDIVISION, PHASE III, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the cul-de-sac and related drainage improvements, for Phase III, Oberlin Reserve Subdivision, constructed on Permanent Parcel Number 14-00-070-000-002 owned by the City of Oberlin be and the same are hereby accepted by the City of Oberlin for ownership, operation, and maintenance pursuant to Section 1311.06 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

*“to allow for the provision of public health and safety services to persons expected to be living within the subdivision at the earliest possible date”,
and shall take effect immediately upon passage.*
