

ORDINANCE NO. 08-14 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR A MASTER FACILITIES PLAN STUDY FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with RP Hughes Architects, Inc., of Columbus, Ohio, for a master facilities plan study for the City of Oberlin in accordance with their proposal dated February 11, 2008, for a fee of \$38,500., plus authorized reimbursables.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

“to ensure that a master facilities plan for Oberlin City government is completed at the earliest possible date in order to enable the City to utilize the study results to plan for the 2009 Municipal budget,”

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
