

ORDINANCE NO. 08-86 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 131 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, TO CLARIFY THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION WITH RESPECT TO RENEWABLE GENERATION AND ENERGY EFFICIENCY/CONSERVATION

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 131 of the Oberlin Codified Ordinances, which pertains to the Public Utilities Commission, is hereby amended to add Section 131.02 as follows:

131.02 – Renewable Generation and Energy Efficiency/ Conservation

- a. The PUC shall advise City Council regarding renewable generation resources by the Municipal Light and Power department.
- b. The PUC shall advise City Council on efforts to encourage water and energy efficiency/conservation by the public.
- c. The PUC shall advise City Council regarding conservation of electricity, natural gas and water by municipal government operations.


SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
