

ORDINANCE NO. 08-97 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE OBERLIN CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE USE OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL AND SCHOOL DISTRICT FACILITIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the City of Oberlin and the Oberlin City School District desire to cooperate as much as possible in the sharing of the use of public facilities in order to reduce or limit additional costs to their respective taxpayers; and

Whereas, the cooperative use of public buildings between the City of Oberlin and the Oberlin City School District will reduce or limit additional costs to their respective taxpayers and represents a proper municipal public purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the Board of Education of the Oberlin City School District for the use of certain City of Oberlin facilities by the Oberlin City Schools and certain Oberlin City School District facilities by the City of Oberlin, a copy of said agreement being attached hereto, marked **Exhibit A** and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to-wit:


“In order to allow for the timely approval of the agreement to enable both parties to utilize the facilities described in the agreement at the earliest possible date.”
