

## ORDINANCE NO. 10-18 AC CMS

### AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH OBERLIN COMMUNITY SERVICES COUNCIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, Oberlin Community Services Council is a non-profit organization that brings important services to economically disadvantaged persons, children, and the general public; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oberlin desires to provide funding to said organization in order that those important services are provided to the residents of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager be, and hereby is, authorized to enter into a contract with Oberlin Community Services Council, whereby the City will provide financial assistance to Oberlin Community Services Council in an amount not to exceed \$35,000, as appropriated in Ordinance No. 09-92 AC CMS, said monies to be used for operating purposes to provide to the residents of Oberlin emergency assistance services and youth tutoring services as set forth in the agreement attached hereto as “**Exhibit A**” and incorporated herein by reference.

**SECTION 2.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

*“to timely provide funds for important contracted services”,  
and shall take effect immediately upon passage.*
