

ORDINANCE 10-69 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF A.J. RILEY, INC. OF NORWALK, OHIO, FOR THE 2010 PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of A.J. Riley, Inc. of Norwalk, Ohio, for the 2010 Pavement Improvement Project in the City of Oberlin, being the lowest and best bid received, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said bid being in the amount of \$274,726.20.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to accept a bid within the time limitations provided by law" and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
