

ORDINANCE NO. 09 - 06 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH WARD DIESEL FILTER SYSTEMS OF ELMIRA, NEW YORK, FOR THE PURCHASE OF DIESEL EXHAUST REMOVAL SYSTEMS FOR THE OBERLIN FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a five-sevenths (5/7th) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Ward Diesel Filter Systems of Elmira, New York, for the purchase of six (6) diesel exhaust removal systems for the City of Oberlin Fire Department, being the lowest and best bid submitted, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for same in the amount of \$51,444.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operations of a municipal department, to wit:


*"to provide usable fire safety equipment as soon as possible
