

ORDINANCE NO. 09- 42 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1501.01 and 1501.02 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, IN ORDER TO INCORPORATE THE LATEST EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE 2009 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Sections 1501.01 and 1501.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, are hereby amended to read as set forth in **Exhibit A** attached hereto.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to adopt the latest and most current edition of the International Fire Code as soon as possible in order to ensure the public safety of Oberlin residents",


and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
