Recreation Budget for 2011

- Recommendation from Council to decrease costs related to recreation activities
- Increase adult recreation fees to 100%
 - Earth Day
 - Co-ed Softball
 - Outdoor basketball tournament
- Youth recreation fees
 - Eliminate Cedar Point trip and replace with activity that is less expensive (zoo/museum)
 - Youth rec fees with sliding scale based on free/reduced lunches; need to provide proof of income
 - Fees for non-residents for youth programs
- **Contracting out the concession stand (R.F.P.)**
 - good plan; still employee Oberlin youth?
- **Parks & Rec Study (Edge Group)**
 - will be meeting with the Edge Group to finalize study from data collected from resident feedback.
 - Look at recreational needs
 - funding? Fees, outside contributions, taxes


Rec Commission Goals for 2011
