AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH POWER LINE SUPPLY OF LIMA, OHIO FOR THE PURCHASE OF UTILITY POLES FOR THE BUTTERNUT 69 KV LINE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FOR THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL LIGHT AND POWER SYSTEM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Power Line Supply, Lima, Ohio, for the purchase of utility poles to replace and relocate the Butternut 69 kV line for the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power System, being the lowest and best bid submitted, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, for the per item prices set forth in the attached bid tabulation, and for a not to exceed amount of \$61,724.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: to accept a utility pole bid as soon as possible in order to ensure the project can be completed before inclement weather sets in, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
