Chapter 1301

1301.01 COMPOSITION

A City Planning Commission is hereby created consisting of five members, to be appointed as provided in Section of the Charter.

1301.02 POWERS AND DUTIES

The powers and duties of the Planning Commission shall be to make plans and maps of the whole or any portion of the City and to have such other powers as are specified by the Ohio Revised Code. (1957 Code §1301.02)

SECTION XIX. BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

E. The City Planning Commission shall have such powers and duties as are or may be conferred upon it by the general laws of the State of Ohio, and such powers as may be conferred upon it by Council, including but not limited to the plan, design, location, removal, relocation, widening, extension, and vacation of streets, parkways, playgrounds and other public places; the approval of plats for subdivision of land; and the zoning of the Municipality for any lawful purpose. The Commission shall from time to time propose to Council the adoption of strategic plans for the Municipality which are consistent with powers conferred upon it, and shall periodically review such plans to ensure their continued relevance.
