Kendal at Oberlin Board Resolution

At the meeting of the Board of Directors of Kendal at Oberlin on May 17, 2016, the following resolution was approved by the Board:

Resolved:

WHEREAS the mission of Kendal at Oberlin cites civic involvement with the wider community and a core value of environmental stewardship;

WHEREAS Kendal embraces fully its responsibility concerning the wise use of energy and deeply held commitments to conserve earth's resources;

THEREFORE the Kendal at Oberlin Board fully supports giving Oberlin customers a choice about the use of their earned Renewable Energy Credits (RECs), having paid higher rates for renewable power.

MOREOVER, as one of the ten larger customers of electricity in Oberlin, Kendal at Oberlin would choose to contribute its RECs rebate toward a sustainable reserve fund whose purpose is to offer grants to Oberlin customers to carry out sustainable projects that will advance the town of Oberlin in its efforts toward carbon-neutrality.
