

ORDINANCE NO. 10 - 66 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$21,000.00 FROM THE CABLE COMMUNICATIONS PROGRAMMING FUND FOR LOCAL CABLE PROGRAMMING EQUIPMENT AND PROGRAMMING LABOR, AND AUTHORIZING A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH OBERLIN CABLE CO-OP, INC. FOR THE LEASE OF SAID EQUIPMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, and the State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby authorized the expenditure of \$21,000.00 from the City of Oberlin Cable Communications Programming Fund for local cable programming equipment and labor, to be used in accordance with the correspondence from Cable Co-op, Inc., dated August 11, 2010, and its attachment, a copy being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a lease agreement with Oberlin Cable Co-op, Inc. for the lease of the cable television equipment referenced in Section 1. for a term of five (5) years, a copy of said lease agreement being attached hereto, marked "Exhibit A", and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
