

ORDINANCE NO. 07-08 AC CMS

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 129.05 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
RELATING TO ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR THE LAW DIRECTOR**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 129.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin, which provides for additional compensation for the Law Director, is hereby amended to read as follows:

129.05 Additional Compensation

The Law Director shall receive additional compensation at such rate as has been set by City Council for the following matters:


1. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and/or Ohio Civil Rights Commission Complaints/Charges;
2. Any Foreclosure actions naming the City as a party;
3. Any other litigation wherein the City is named as a party;
4. Income Tax Collections;
5. Utility Collections;
6. Appeals to the Zoning Board of Appeals, Planning Commission, Housing Renewal Commission, Civil Service Commission, State Board of Building Standards (OBBS), State of Ohio Board of Building Appeals (OBBA);
7. Administrative Appeals of any sort, whether to Oberlin City Council or the Courts;
8. U.S. or Ohio EPA charges or violations naming the City of Oberlin;
9. Community Housing Improvement Program (CHIP) matters;
10. Any other matters wherein additional compensation is authorized by City Council Motion.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
