

ORDINANCE NO. 07-23 AC CMS

**AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING GARY BOYLE TREASURER OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN,
OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Gary Boyle is hereby appointed Treasurer of the City of
Oberlin, Ohio, effective immediately.


SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of
this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were
adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this
Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in
meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including
Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual
daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:


“to provide for a Treasurer for the City of Oberlin at the earliest
possible time in order to ensure the effective management of the City” and shall
take effect immediately upon passage.
