

ORDINANCE NO. 07-47 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH COMDOC, INC., OF BROADVIEW HEIGHTS, OHIO, THROUGH THE STATE OFFICE OF PURCHASING FOR THE LEASE OF AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES FOR VARIOUS COPIERS FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04 and City of Oberlin Resolution No. R88-7, the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with COMDOC, Inc., of Broadview Heights, Ohio, for the lease of and maintenance services for various copiers for the City of Oberlin, Ohio, in an amount not to exceed \$2,656.55 per month effective July 1, 2007 for a term of thirty-nine (39) months for ten (10) copiers, subject, however, to annual appropriation. This program includes up to 57,000 Black & White copies per month and 3,000 full color copies per month; \$.009 per copy for black & white copies in excess of 57,000 per month and \$.08 per copy for color copies in excess of 3,000 copies per month.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to immediately enter into a lease and maintenance agreement for ten (10) copiers, and maintenance agreements for the remaining copiers in various city departments at the earliest possible date to ensure the continued operation of municipal government", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
