

## ORDINANCE NO. 07-61 AC CMS

### AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF 7L CONSTRUCTION, INC., OF BELLEVUE, OHIO, FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO HAMILTON STREET AND DECLARING AND EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of 7L Construction, Inc., of Bellevue, Ohio, for the improvements to Hamilton Street in the City of Oberlin, being the lowest and best bid submitted, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said bid being in an amount not to exceed \$431,215.63.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipality, to wit:

"to accept a bid within the time limitations provided by law", and shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
