

ORDINANCE NO. 07-97 AC CMS

**AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE 95-27 AC CMS WHICH
ESTABLISHED COMPENSATION FOR THE POSITION OF ACTING CITY
MANAGER FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 95-27 AC CMS, which established
compensation for the Acting City Manager of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, is hereby
rescinded.

SECTION 2 That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions
of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were
adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this
Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in
meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including
Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3 That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual
daily operation of a municipal department, to wit

2008 "*


