

RESOLUTION NO. R08-05 CMS

A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AT THE GENERAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 4, 2008, THE QUESTION OF PROVIDING FOR A ONE-FIFTH OF ONE PERCENT (1/5%) LEVY ON INCOME FOR TEN (10) YEARS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, hereby requests and directs that the Board of Elections of Lorain County, Ohio, place on the ballot at the General Election to be held on November 4, 2008, the question of whether Ordinance No. 08-36 AC CMS, providing for a one-fifth of one percent (1/5%) levy on income for a period of ten (10) years, effective January 1, 2009, through December 31, 2018, be passed.

SECTION 2. That the form of the question to be placed on the ballot to be presented to the electors of the City of Oberlin shall be as follows:

A MAJORITY AFFIRMATIVE VOTE IS NECESSARY FOR PASSAGE

Shall Ordinance No. 08-36 AC CMS, providing for a one-fifth of one percent (1/5%) levy on income for the purpose of providing funds for capital improvements and general operating expenses for the City of Oberlin, and including debt service on obligations issued to finance such activities, for ten (10) years, effective January 1, 2009, be passed?


