Purchase a Home Composting Bin and we will reimburse you up to \$100* of the cost of the bin.



Bring your receipt to the Public Works Department at City Hall, 85 S. Main St. between 8:00am and 4:30pm, M-F and we'll process your reimbursement.



Why compost? It's easy; it's cheap; it enriches soil!

Composting improves soil fertility, plant health, drainage on heavy soils and soil aeration. It reduces water pollution by reducing the need for fertilizers, which prevent algae blooms and fish kills in lakes and streams. Composting reduces your ecological footprint by reducing food and yard waste being landfilled.

TV RECYCLING MADE EASY



***Drop off your tube TV (smaller than 32") or your Flat Panel TV including LCD, Plasma, LED (smaller than 50") or Portable TV at any [Best Buy store](#) for a \$25 fee. Then bring your receipt to the Public Works Department and we'll refund your \$25 recycling fee!**

One reimbursement per household for each program. Offers only available to residents residing within Oberlin City limits. Receipts must be dated between July 18 and October 29, 2018 and **submitted to the City by October 31, 2018.*
