### ORDINANCE No. 19-75 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SOUTHEAST SECURITY CORP. OF SHARON CENTER OHIO, AS VALUE ADDED RESELLER THROUGH ANIXTER'S OMNIA PARTNERS/NATIONAL IPA CONTRACTS NOS. R161701 AND R170501 FOR CABLING AND NETWORKING PRODUCTS AND SECURITY SYSTEMS SERVICES PURSUANT TO SECTION 9.48 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE FOR THE OBERLIN POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL COURT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the authority granted under Ohio Revised Code Section 9.48(C), Joint Purchasing Programs, the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Southeast Security Corp. of Sharon Center, as Value Added Reseller through Anixter's Omnia Partners/National IPA Contracts Nos. R161701 and R170501 for Cabling and Networking Products and Security Systems Services of \$49,940.59 and \$13,099.45 respectively and a combined purchase price of \$63,040.04.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: *to authorize the purchase of a Security Camera System as soon as possible to ensure the efficient operation of the Police Department and Oberlin Municipal Court*, and shall take effect immediately upon passage; and provided that it is elevated to emergency status by the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council and receives the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council upon final passage, it shall go into full force and effect from and immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
