Oberlin School Community:

Ohio Governor, Mike DeWine, held a press conference on March 12, 2020, to address the current status of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) crisis. Governor DeWine announced that school districts would be engaged in alternative educational opportunities (On-Line / Educational Packets) for three weeks beginning Tuesday, March 17, 2020 through Friday, April 3, 2020. At this time, school is scheduled to resume on Monday, April 6, 2020. The district will have Spring Break during the week of March 23 to March 27, 2020.

Following Governor DeWine's directive, students <u>will</u> have school on Monday, March 16, 2020. Students will need to clean out lockers and take home all personal materials to allow our staff to provide a thorough cleaning of the school. Due to this being a very rare situation, the district will excuse all absences occurring on Friday, March 13 and Monday, March 16, 2020.

Students will <u>not</u> report to school on Tuesday, March 17, 2020. Teachers will report to work and complete Continuing Education Plans for students in grades PreK-12. Teacher's Continuing Education Plans will provide two weeks of instructional materials (excluding Spring Break week). The district will place all Continuing Education Plans and instructional materials on the district website. Student's will have access to this information on Tuesday, March 17 after 4:00 pm. Students will return all completed work on Monday, April 6, 2020.

If families are unable to access instructional materials on-line, the district has printed Continuing Education Plan packets. You can pick up the packets at your student's school between the following hours:

Tuesday, March 17 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm Wednesday, March 18 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Thursday, March 19 8:00 am to 5:00 pm

If you are unable to access the instructional materials on-line or pick up the documents, please contact your student's school directly during the above times to make arrangements. During this three week period there will be limited access to the central office and district buildings and all activities are cancelled.

We understand that this situation has caused a great deal of inconvenience for our families. We want to thank you for your patience and understanding. As we gather additional information, the district will keep you informed.
