ORDINANCE No. 20-26 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1501.26 OF THE OBERLIN CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO ADDRESS THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE FIRE CODE BOARD OF APPEALS, THE APPEALS PROCESS, AND ADD APPEALS OF THE FIRE CODE BOARD OF APPEALS DECISIONS ARE MADE TO THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS.

WHEREAS, the current Fire Code Board of Appeals consist of the Chair of Council, an interested resident and the City Manager; and,

WHEREAS, City Manager shall not serve on Boards and Commissions per Section XIV sub-section B of the City Charter and,

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin shall have a Fire Code Board of Appeals to hear any appeals on decisions rendered by the Fire Chief or municipal Fire Safety Inspector pertaining to the City of Oberlin Fire Prevention Codes; and,

WHEREAS, the amendment to Chapter 1501.76 as set forth in Exhibit A be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the amendment to Chapter 1501.26 of the Oberlin Codified Ordinance as are set forth in Exhibit A be and are hereby adopted.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
