ORDINANCE No. 20-30 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PAVEMENT TECHNOLOGY, INC., OF WESTLAKE, OHIO, THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM TO SUPPLY AND PLACE RECLAMITE® ASPHALT REJUVENATOR ON SELECT STREETS IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1. That pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01(B) and upon the approval of the request to participate in the ODOT Cooperative Purchasing Program made pursuant to Ordinance No. 17-19 AC CMS, the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Pavement Technology, Inc. of Westlake, Ohio, to supply and place Reclamite® Asphalt Rejuvenator on select streets in the City of Oberlin for the not to exceed price of \$67,092.50.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: **to provide for the Reclamite® application as soon as possible to extend the useful life of the City's streets** and provided that it is elevated to emergency status by the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council and receives the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council upon final passage, it shall go into full force and effect from and immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
