Purpose: The Music Fund was created on the recommendation of the Finance Commission to the vestry in 2010. The fund was created by various accumulated and unencumbered stocks being held in the Christ Church portfolio with UBS. The income from the sale of these funds was rolled over into the Diocesan Joint Investment Fund with the intent of setting up an endowment to fund the music program at Christ Church and especially the choral scholars program to augment our choir. The vestry also authorized rolling two other long held funds, the Bubb Fund and the Severance Fund into this music endowment. Interest from this fund is deposited in income line 4-3-03 Music Investment income.

The Operating Endowment was established by action of the Vestry on recommendation of the Finance Commission. Money which had been reserved as a Contingency Fund was merged with bequests from the estates of Emma Layman, Clara Lucioli, Katherine Prescott, and the Rev. Chave McCracken. The intention is that only interest earned and not principal will augment operating income as needed. This fund was also set up to provide a place for future bequests to reside for the purpose of supporting our parish yearly operating expenses. The Christ Church Operating Endowment was established in November 2010.



In September 1974, after the death of their parents (Walter in 1967 and Virginia in 1974), Eric and Evan Nord gifted Christ Church with 2,680 shares of Nordson Stock @10.50 a share. The income from this gift was put in what was then called the "Advance" Fund, the principle and interest to be used for capital improvement to parish, buildings, and grounds (1974). The Walter and Virginia Nord Fund was separated from the Advance Fund in June of 1989. At that time, and with Eric's consent, the Finance Commission proposed to the Vestry and the Vestry approved a redefinition of the use for interest income of the Nord Fund: to be spent on capital expenditures for the parish of Christ Church including property maintenance, repairs, and improvements. In a conversation with Eric and Jane Nord at the time of the Nordson stock split in 2000 and the Chapel Grove dedication, Eric explained to Dean Wolfe and Fr. Brian Wilbert that the intention of the redefinition was to give generous latitude to the Vestry whose fiduciary responsibility was to administer the monies in the spirit of good stewardship.



The Christ Church Youth Ministry fund was established as part of the Planting for Tomorrow campaign which our parish entered into with the Diocese of Ohio in 2014. The purpose is to put aside income from our Planting from Tomorrow funds returned to the parish from our Diocese to help provide for a shared ordained clergyperson between Christ Church and St. Andrew' church, Elyria. A portion of these funds enables us to pay our part of the Rev. Gregory Stark's position as the Christ Church/St. Andrew's Curate for Children, Youth, and Young Adults. Fr. Stark started his four year contract with us in July of 2017 .
