- The installation of new equipment at the Spring St. playground is nearing completion.
- Cedar Street is getting an electrical upgrade from W Lorain St. to Morgan St. Current poles will be replaced and moved away from the curb towards the sidewalk. Several trees will need to be removed and/or trimmed. New trees will be planted.
- The EV charging station behind 69 S Main St. was removed and the new station should be installed next week.
- A presentation from Oberlin College about its sustainable infrastructure thermal heating project is expected to come before Council at its April 5th meeting. Construction is expected to begin in May.

- Ordinance establishing a Large Industrial Rate for electric service. (1st)
- Ordinance to amend administrative expenses for municipal utilities to reflect the establishment of a Large Industrial Service Rate. (1st)
- Ordinance to approve quarterly budget adjustments. (1st, E)
- Resolution to transition administration of community organization service contracts from Council to City Manager. (1st)
