City Offices Reorganization

In an effort to improve organizational effectiveness and customer service, the Engineering Office (City Engineer, Engineering Technician & Storm Water Coordinator) has moved to Oberlin City Hall at 85 South Main Street to join other Public Works Department administration offices. Also, the City's Human Resources Administrator, Administrative Coordinator of Communications and the Sustainability Coordinator have moved to the 2nd floor offices at "Old City Hall" at 69 South Main Street. The City Manager's Office and Planning & Development Department remain in the 2nd floor offices at "Old City Hall" and the Finance/Utility Office and Recreation Office remain in the 1st floor offices. Snow & Ice Removal

Overnight Parking Ordinance - "Snow Ban"

Oberlin residents can once again recycle items through our free subscription-based curbside recycling program. Recycling is no longer mandatory in Oberlin, so residents will need to subscribe to participate in the recycling program.

Items Accepted in Curbside Recycling:

- 🛟 Paper Newspaper, Envelopes, Mail, Phone Books, Magazines
- 🎝 Plastic #1 & #2 Water/Soda Bottles, Milk Jugs, Shampoo **Bottles, Detergent Containers**
- Cardboard Flattened Boxes, Food Boxes With Liners Removed, File Folders, Poster Board
- Metal Aluminum Cans, Food Cans

Recyclables should be EMPTY, CLEAN & DRY before placing in your recycling cart. Place recyclables LOOSE & UNBAGGED in your cart. NO SORTING REQUIRED!
