- An OMLPS repair is forthcoming that will require a complete power outage for the City for about 3 hours. The repair is tentatively planned for next weekend. The City will send out details with specific times.
- The City is discussing and preparing for a safe reopening of city offices and in person meetings.
- POWER has weatherized 5 homes and has 3 more scheduled.
- Oberlin's EV Car Share has 66 drivers registered and has been used at a rate of more than double the expected goal for its first month.
- The Fire Department has responded to 352 calls so far this year, and has placed 2 new LifePak cardiac monitors into service.
- The Spring Street parking lot construction is expected to begin in June.
