ORDINANCE No. 22-49 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE 21-75 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH VALLEY FORD TRUCK, INC., OF CLEVELAND, OHIO THROUGH THE STATE OFFICE OF PURCHASING FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2022 FORD F550 4x4 CHASSIS EQUIPPED WITH THE STELLAR SHUTTLE 84-10 FLEX HOOK LIFT SYSTEM AND A 9' STAINLESS STEEL DUMP BODY FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 21-75, City Council authorized the City Manager to enter into a contract with Valley Ford Truck Inc. through the State Office of Purchasing for the purchase of a 2022 Ford F600 4x4 chassis equipped with the Stellar Shuttle 84-10 Flex Hooklift System and 9' stainless steel dump body; and

WHEREAS, due to unprecedented supply chain issues in the automotive industry, the Ford Motor Company has been unable to fulfill all orders and, as a result, the Ford F600 4x4 chassis intended for the City of Oberlin Public Works Department was not built.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance 21-75 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04 and City of Oberlin Resolution No. R88-7, the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Valley Ford Truck, Inc. of Cleveland, Ohio, for the purchase of a 2022 Ford F550 4x4 Chassis equipped with the Stellar Shuttle 84-10 Flex Hook Lift System and a 9' stainless steel dump body for the City of Oberlin Public Works Department for the purchase price of \$141,390.00.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: to authorize the purchase of the Ford F550 equipped with the Stellar Hook Lift System and the 9' dump body as soon as possible to ensure the efficient operation of the Public Works Department and provided that it is elevated to emergency status by the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council and receives the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council upon final passage, it shall go into full force and effect from and immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
